Obituary

Mrs. Rosie Mae Perry Bridges, was born on June 27, 1938 in Granada, MS to the late Marshall and Rosie Bell Cook Perry. Along with others that preceded her in death are five brothers, Henry, James, Morris, Marshall and Charles Perry, two sister, Mamie Perry and Clyde Perry-Kincaid, and a daughter-in-law, Alice Johnson Bridges.

During her early years in Mississippi, Rosie became a member of Bellflower Church with her family. She was a graduate of Grenada High School, Natchez College, Mississippi Valley State University and Indiana University where she earned her Bachelor's Degree in Education to become a School teacher. Rosie taught school in Mississippi for a few years until she met the late Eddie Bridges Sr., and moved with him to Cleveland, Ohio . They were married in December of 1966. Six years later in 1972 a son was born, Eddie Bridges Jr. While teaching in the Cleveland Public School District, she also received her Master's Degree in Education at John Carroll University in Cleveland, Ohio. In 1984, she devoted her life as a member of St. Henry's Church and Holy Spirit Church. Rosie had a passion for teaching children until she retired in 1993, even during and after that time her hobbies she loved were cooking, traveling different places, visiting her relatives, taking care of her garden and watching sports, in which she was a die hard basketball fan.

Rosie departed this life on January 13, 2022, at the age of 83. She leaves to cherish her precious memories of her loving son, Eddie Jr., stepson, Jeruip Bridges of Memphis, TN, four stepchildren: Christopher, Shayla, Samuel and Clayton Johnson of Cleveland, OH and a host of other relatives including nieces, nephews, cousins, in-laws, friends and step-great grandchildren.
