I know you're by my side

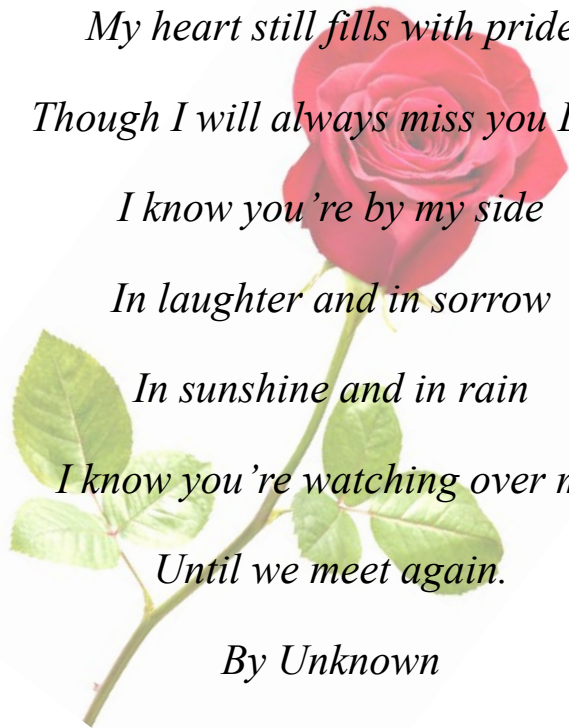
